Past Juventus exhibits have displayed the work of ten to twelve artists from areas as far as Nova Scotia and California, as well as the Midwest, and have presented jurors with a wide range of styles and mediums. Past judges have included Tom Palazzolo, filmmaker, and Hamza Walker, Director of Education for the Renaissance Society at the University of Chicago. The opening reception last year attracted over three hundred guests and the interest of such Chicago notables as the Peter Miller Gallery.
